About the Youth Board at The Mighty Creatives

Our Youth Board is a part of us hearing the voices of young people, where the Youth Board members help to lead the work of The Mighty Creatives, while gaining new skills and experiences. As a charity, we have a Board of Trustees, who are a group of individuals that have responsibility for the management of The Mighty Creatives, like Governors in schools. Our Youth Board is the equivalent of the Board of Trustees, except Youth led. We want you to bring your personal experiences, ideas and passions to the Youth Board, so we can hear, empower and champion your voices.

So, what's the role of the Youth Board?

In our monthly online meetings, we will be updated on the work of The Mighty Creatives, and discuss some key topic points. The Youth Board members responsibilities will be to:

- Help create positive community change through arts and culture. It's not just about making art; it's about making change, one creative act at a time.
- Be part of and help build a network of likeminded young people across the region.
- Help lead TMC's work and have your say on our next steps and the development of our programmes.
- Design, develop and deliver youth-led projects.

From making decisions on fundraising to planning events for young people, having a role on the Youth Board can open up varied learning and development opportunities.

FAQ's

What about payments or other similar benefits?

The role is a voluntary one and so compulsory meetings will not involve any payments. However, being on the Youth Board can lead to opportunities to lead and run extra projects which will be paid for and assessed on a case-by-case basis.

What about travel and expenses?

The Mighty Creatives is based in Leicester, our Youth Board meetings are currently taking place online, but there may be times when Youth Board members will need to travel to Board meetings and events that take place around the East Midlands. Board Members will therefore need to travel across the region on occasion. You would be able to claim reasonable expenses (for example bus or rail fares, etc.) to get to meetings or events.

Can I stop being a Youth Board member?

Yes! You could choose to step down at any time if you wished to.

We would like Youth Board Members to be active and involved in the Board. If you couldn't fulfil your responsibilities to either your or our expectations, we would discuss ending your membership of the Board.
